

**Junior Sports Day – Thursday 14<sup>th</sup> June 2018**  
**UEA Sportspark - 9.45 to 11.45 a.m. – Years 3 and 4**  
**UEA Sportspark – 1 to 2.50 p.m. – Years 5 and 6**

Dear Parents/Carers,

The above event takes place at the UEA Sportspark on **Thursday 14th June**. This year we have again allocated children to colour groups as below, and would like children to please wear shirts which match their colour:

**Green                      Yellow                      Blue                      Red**

Your child needs to **come to school in their PE kit** (shorts/appropriate T- shirt/tracksuit/plimsolls or trainers etc) and bring with them a waterproof jacket, water bottle and snack. Assuming it is a fine day, children should come to school having also applied sun lotion and wearing a hat.

Parents can park in the Sportspark car park free of charge, however there are limited spaces. If it is full you may park in the UEA car park at a cost of approximately £1.00 per hour. Entry to the Sportspark is 60p per person to spectators – free to Sportspark card holders. Year 3 and 4 children will be transported to and from the UEA by coach. Year 5 and 6 pupils will be transported to the UEA by coach but parents will be able to collect children at the end of the afternoon. Parents of these pupils should complete the slip below and pass to the class teacher so we know who will be collecting children at the end of the afternoon. Children whose parents cannot take them back to school will be walked back by members of staff. They will arrive back at school by 3.20 p.m. The afternoon's events will finish by approximately 2.50 p.m. allowing parents enough time to collect siblings from school. **We are asking for a donation of £2.50 per Year 3 / 4 child towards the transport costs and £1.50 per Year 5 / 6 pupil, payable via Wisepay.** The cost of hiring the UEA facilities has been fully covered by the school. Year 5 and 6 pupils will have a slightly earlier lunch. It would be helpful if your child could have a packed lunch that day. Pupils eligible for free school meals can order a packed lunch from the school.

On **Tuesday 12<sup>th</sup> June** the children will be walking up to the UEA Sportspark to take part in field events. Each child will take part in a variety of field events, including high jump, long jump and throwing.

Year 3 and Year 4 children will walk up to the UEA at 9 a.m. and will be back for lunch.

Years 5 and 6 will leave at approximately 11.30 a.m. and will have their packed lunch at the UEA before their afternoon sports activities. These children should bring a packed lunch or order one from the school if they are eligible for free school meals.

They will be back at school by 3.20 p.m.

All children should have a water bottle and snack to take up to the UEA.

Again, please make sure your child comes to school that day in PE kit, and fully prepared for all weather conditions (see paragraph above). Ideally, the children would also wear an appropriately coloured T-shirt.

As most of you have already signed the Parental Consent Form for this school year, giving your permission for any local trips, we are not attaching a permission slip to this letter. If you have any objections to your child taking part, or any queries, please contact us.

Parents are very welcome to watch the main Sports Day on Thursday June 14<sup>th</sup>, but we are not expecting parents to attend on June 12<sup>th</sup>.
