Key Stage 2 Games



Dear Parents,

For Games lessons the following kit is required:

1. Usual shorts and T-shirt in school colours (red or white). Black shorts are permissible **but not** football strip.
2. A pair of trainers to wear outside.
3. Ideally, your child will have a pair of **indoor** plimsolls which are never used outside. This footwear needs to be in school alongside the outdoor trainers in case of bad weather. For some indoor activities the children will have bare feet, e.g. gymnastics.
4. As the weather gets colder the children will need a tracksuit or warm suitable jumpers (any colour). They should not wear school sweatshirts or fleeces for games lessons. A waterproof jacket is also useful as some of the PE lessons have to take place outside, regardless of weather, particularly towards the end of the autumn term when the stage is up in the hall and classes are practising plays etc.
5. No watches or jewellery can be worn. Children with ear studs have to remove them if they are able to or cover them with their own tape.
6. Water bottles are especially important on P.E. days.
7. We shall assume that your child is fit to participate in a games lesson unless we receive a letter or email from you to explain this or a phone call to the office with a valid reason. Children who are not fit for games will change into their kit to be a helper unless getting changed is difficult due to an injury.
8. Please make sure that any medical needs (inhalers, additional snacks, etc.) are explained to us in good time.
9. All children (boys and girls) with longer hair must tie it back.
10. Shin pads are a good idea for hockey and football. Gum shields are not necessary but you may provide them if you feel strongly - or if it is particularly advisable for your child.
11. If your child does not have his/her P.E. Kit on P.E. days this will be logged and a note will be sent home.
