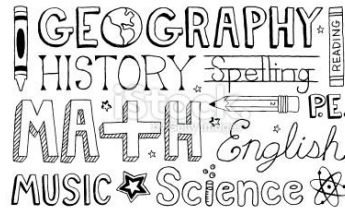




## YEAR 4 Spring 1 2019 Curriculum Letter
