## To the parents of children in Year 3 - Swallows

Dear Parents and Carers,

### ***How Hill 2019***

Every year the school organises a residential trip to How Hill for the children in Year 3. This year Swallows class is provisionally booked for **Monday 1<sup>st</sup> – Wednesday 3<sup>rd</sup> July 2019**.

We hope that all children in the class will want to participate. Past experience tells us that children of this age can cope very well with two nights away from home and for many it becomes a memorable milestone.

How Hill is a beautiful house and garden surrounded by fields and Broads, situated in Ludham, not far from Horning. It is a perfect venue ~ self contained and offering opportunities for environmental studies and activities such as orienteering and pond dipping. Toad Hole Cottage, in the grounds, takes the children back in time to the turn of the century.

In the evenings we use the classroom to follow up our findings, play games and make the most of the extensive grounds.

The children will be accompanied by at least four adults from school and there are a number of instructors at How Hill who accompany groups of children during the day. You may like to talk to parents of older children if you have doubts about the value of this trip.

**Cost:** The total cost of the trip is £145. This would also cover the cost of coach transport to and from How Hill. You will be able to pay the full amount in one payment or spread the cost by paying in regular instalments. No child will be excluded from the trip if a contribution is not forthcoming but if there are insufficient funds, the trip may not proceed. If this is the case the deposit will be returned to you. We might be able to access some financial support for a small number of children through applying to some local charitable organisations such as the Joanna Scott Foundation. Please speak to Mr. Henery in confidence about this by Friday 1<sup>st</sup> March 2019 [head@cringleford.norfolk.sch.uk](mailto:head@cringleford.norfolk.sch.uk).

To secure the booking we need you to complete the attached slip indicating that your child will be participating, together with a **non-refundable deposit of £55 (paid via Wisepay)** per child by Friday 1<sup>st</sup> March 2019

Once numbers are finalised we will send out further details regarding payment, including the opportunity to pay in instalments.

If you would like to discuss the trip further, please see your child's class teacher, although there will be a detailed meeting for parents on Tuesday 30<sup>th</sup> April 2019 at 2.30 p.m.
