

Dear Parents / Carers,

Forest school - Stone Age Survival Day

– Monday 14th September 2020 Swallows

- Wednesday 16th September 2020 Swifts

We appreciate this is relatively short notice but we have just been given the go ahead for this exciting launch of our topic this half term. We are planning to take the children to The Grove woodland near the Willow Centre for a Stone Age Survival day. We will be participating in a range of Stone Age activities designed to give the children an idea of what life might have been like in this period. The day will provide the children with valuable learning experiences which we would not otherwise be able to provide in the classroom setting.

The activities will take place on Monday 14th September/ Wednesday 16th September and will take place during the normal school day. The experience will be led by Forest School leaders, and will include activities such as building dens, making a fire, charcoal painting along with some games relating to finding water and hunting, for which there will be a charge of £7.00 per child. Parents of children in receipt of Pupil Premium (currently receiving free school meals or has been in receipt of Free School Meals at some point during the last six years) are not expected to pay the full contribution. No child will be excluded from the activity if a contribution is not forthcoming but if there are insufficient funds, the activity will not go ahead. As usual, at the moment, the children will need a fruit snack, packed lunch and a drink for that day which we will eat in the classroom.

The children must come suitably clothed in warm, old clothes (non-school uniform) and bring wet weather gear including **named wellies or trainers and indoor shoes** as the visit will go ahead regardless of the weather. We will need them to change their shoes when we return to the classroom, even if it is not wet, after being outside to keep the classrooms as clean as possible.

We appreciate that this is short notice due to being so close to the start of term but would ask that you make payment by Monday 14th September 2020 if at all possible. If not please could you make payment by Friday 18th September 2020 at 17:00.
