

At Cringleford Primary we aim to provide a high-quality languages education to inspire our children to develop the knowledge and skills to be able to communicate in another language other than English and to deepen their understanding of the world as a global citizen.

Throughout the KS2 MFL curriculum, children are taught an appropriate balance of spoken and written language which lays the foundations for practical communication and further foreign language learning at KS3.

As children move through KS2 they will understand and communicate ideas, facts and feelings in speech and writing, focused on familiar and routine matters, using their knowledge of phonology, grammatical structures and vocabulary. Their learning in Year 3 & 4 in Spanish will be built upon in Year 5&6 with French where they will be able to develop their language learning strategies and knowledge about language. This model will enable them to make progress in both languages and equip them for the broad choice they confront at high school.
