

# Parent Information for Year 5 Hawks 2021

Dear Parents,

Welcome to Year 5 and Hawks. As we are not able to meet you at our "Meet the Teacher" meeting this year we have recorded a video introducing you to year 5 which can be accessed on the school website under the Parents tab. <https://www.cringelford.norfolk.sch.uk/>

## Staffing

Mrs Marlee will be supporting the class in the morning and Mrs Fowler will be supporting in the afternoons.

Mr Colbeck will be teaching the class PE and Mrs Edwards will be teaching music on a Tuesday afternoon.

## Curriculum Plan

Our topic this term is **Space Explorers**. You will already have received the curriculum map which gives more details about what we will be learning but the exact activities may change depending on where the children's interest takes us. Many of the children are already excited to find out more about how space exploration has developed and also to see if they have what it takes to be an astronaut.

## Reading

Reading together is one of the most valuable things parents can do to help children develop as learners. Children should have a reading book with them in school every day. This could be chosen from school or a book from home (please make sure it is named).

Ideally we would like all children to **read at home daily for 10 -15 minutes**. The **minimum we would like is 3 times a week**. If your child is a fluent reader, it is still important to read with them at least once a week. You will then be able to discuss the plot and ask questions to check their understanding. A list of possible questions you could use is attached and the children are also going to bring home a laminated bookmark with useful questions on. It would be great if you could read to your child at least once a week to share stories which they might not otherwise choose.

When the children have completed a reading session, they can write in their reading record themselves or you can record for them, but please can each week be signed by an adult. Please use a new page of the reading record each week, as this makes it much clearer to see how often your child is reading. We will collect the reading records **each Monday** to monitor the range and amount of reading taking place; children will be rewarded with prize points.

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## **Homework**

Homework will consist of regular **reading**; weekly **spellings & handwriting**; a **Maths** activity per week and an ongoing **topic** project.

Maths homework and spellings/handwriting will be set on a Tuesday and should be completed by the following Monday. Reading records will also be checked on a Monday.

If your child struggles with a piece of homework, please let us know so we can help them in school. If children regularly fail to hand homework in, they may be kept in at lunch to complete it.

We encourage continued practice of times tables. This can be supported using Times Tables Rock Stars <https://play.ttrockstars.com/>. Your child has been given a label with their login and password in their reading records.

## **Feedback to children**

Children's progress is monitored through marking, discussion and assessments. A whole school marking system is used and includes children being given opportunities to edit and improve their writing in green pens.

Please remember children with mid to long hair will need a hair tie and earrings must be removed or taped if they are new piercings.
