

Dear Parents / Carers,

Stone Age Survival Day

– Tuesday 14th September 2021 Swallows

- Wednesday 15th September 2021 Swifts

In order to launch our Stone Age to Iron Age topic for this half term, we are planning to take the children to The Grove Woodland near the Willow Centre for a Stone Age Survival day next week. They will be participating in a range of Stone Age activities designed to give them an idea of what life might have been like in in pre-history!

The activities will take place on Tuesday 14th September or Wednesday 15th September and will take place during the normal school day. The experience will be led by a Forest School leader, and will include activities such as building shelters, making a fire and charcoal painting, along with some games relating to finding water and hunting. The charge for this whole day experience would have been £6.00 per child. However, some of you have already paid £3 towards a Survival Day (for both classes) back in the summer which had to be cancelled, which will be put towards this cost. If you have yet to pay for the Survival Day we will send you a text as a reminder to pay for this. The reduced cost of the Stone Age Survival Day will be set at £3 so that we are able to cover the £6 total cost of the experience.

Parents of children in receipt of Pupil Premium (currently receiving free school meals or has been in receipt of Free School Meals at some point during the last six years) are not expected to pay the full contribution. No child will be excluded from the activity if a contribution is not forthcoming but if there are insufficient funds, the activity will not go ahead. The children must come suitably clothed in warm, old clothes (non-school uniform) and bring wet weather gear including **named wellies or trainers and indoor shoes** as the visit will go ahead regardless of the weather. We will need them to change their shoes when we return to the classroom, even if it is not wet, to keep the classrooms as clean as possible.

Could we ask that you make payment by Monday 13th September if at all possible.

Completion of the online WisePay form is the equivalent of providing parental consent for this event. If you have any issues accessing WisePay please contact the office straightaway.
