Cricket Taster Session



Earlier this week, Miss Fish accompanied a group of girls from Year 3 and Year 4 who had been selected to attend Norwich High School for Girls to attend a cricket taster.

The girls were put into three groups and mixed in with Norwich High School for girls Year 4 students.

All groups then rotated around a series of skill stations, throwing, catching, batting and bowling.

They then played a short match to bring together the techniques learnt. All the girls were a credit to our school and had a lovely afternoon meeting new people and trying out cricket.



Sports Equipment for Schools



Sports Equipment for Schools gives primary schools the chance to win new sports items. The goal is for children to 'Get Out and Get Active' and help them understand the benefits of daily exercise.

Schools can win a share of the sports equipment available by collecting daily tokens in your local newspapers. The school with the highest token-to-pupil ratio will receive an Athletics kit worth over £1000, plus a visit from a professional GB athlete to inspire and encourage pupils to follow their dreams. The second prize will be a £750 Sports Hall Triathlon kit.

Every other school with 1000 or more tokens will receive either a 'Throw Pack' or an 'Infant Pack' worth £120.

We will be collecting the tokens printed daily in the Eastern Daily Press (two on Saturday), Norwich Evening News (two on Saturday) and weekly in the North Norfolk News, Dereham Times, Fakenham Times, Beccles & Bungay Journal, Lowestoft Journal and Great Yarmouth Mercury. The final tokens will be in papers on 16th July.

We have a collection box in the lobby of the school office for the tokens. Many thanks for your support with this.
