



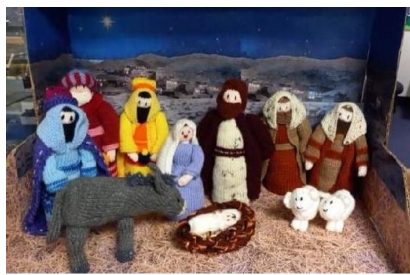
Year Group Christmas Performances 2022

Christmas dinner day - All lunches MUST be booked in advance - Please follow the link above.

The whole school will have Christmas dinner on the same day with an extended lunch-time. Children may wear Christmas clothing (i.e. festive colours, tinsel etc not necessarily Christmas jumpers) for the day, please do not feel that you have to go and purchase something specially.

In order to make this as straight forward as possible for the kitchen we will be asking you to pre-order lunch for your child using the link above even if they will be bringing a home packed lunch on that day. **Please complete one lunch order per child.**

School lunches will be at the usual cost of £2.30 for children in Years 3-6 (unless you are in receipt of means tested Free School Meals) and should be paid for on WisePay in the normal manner, in advance where possible by adding £2.30 to your child's WisePay account. There is no cost to those children in Years R-2 as they are in receipt of universal free school meals.

Norse are unable to provide a halal chicken option, therefore the vegetarian option should be selected for your child if required. If your child has a pre-agreed special diet menu provided by Norse, their meal will be adapted accordingly.

These options will be the only choices available, there will **NOT** be a jacket potato or school packed lunch available, with the exception of those children that are registered as Pupil Premium who can pre-order a school packed lunch as an alternative.

The pre-order system will close at 9.00am on Friday 2nd December.

We cannot provide additional meals on the day for those that have not pre-ordered, home packed lunch must be provided if this is the case.
